SUBJECT: SQUADRON UNIFORM POLICY

I. BDU's: Wear sleeves-up from 1 May to 1 Oct. Cadet Squadron Commander or above may decide to wear sleeves up or down if weather necessitates.

II. Blues: Only cadet officers, Cadet Executive Staff, and Cadet Line Staff will wear the Service Coat and/or shoulder cords according to the following conditions:

1) Service Coats:

a). Squadron Executive Staff may wear the service coat IF ALL Squadron Executive Staff members (CC, DC, XO, FS) wear a CAPM 39-1 compliant Service Coat complete with appropriate tie and insignia.

b). Flight Commanders may only wear the service coat IF ALL Flight Commanders AND ALL Executive Staff wear a CAPM 39-1 compliant Service Coat complete with appropriate tie and insignia.

c). Flight Sergeants may only wear the service coat IF ALL Flight Sergeants AND ALL Flight Commanders wear a CAPM 39-1 compliant Service Coat complete with appropriate tie and insignia.

d). Exception: Cadets of any rank or position may wear Service coats when performing Color Guard duty if everyone on the Color Guard team has them.

2) Shoulder Cords:

- a) Cadet staff may wear shoulder cords of Wing-approved colors on class A and B uniforms.
- b) Executive Staff (CC, DC, XO): blue on white cord, no device.
- c) First Sergeant: black cord, no device.
- d) Flight Commanders: red on white cord, with red device.
- e) Flight Sergeants: red on white cord, no device.

III. PT: Black T-shirt, black or blue shorts (no shorter than mid-thigh) or sweatpants, running/tennis shoes. Street shoes or combat boots are forbidden (COWG policy).
