## CADET OF THE QUARTER PROGRAM



This Instruction defines the Cadet of the Quarter program for cadets at the Evergreen Composite Squadron.

1. To provide an objective system for friendly competition, Evergreen Composite Squadron has established a Cadet of the Quarter program. Cadets earn points by their performance as they progress through the program. Scores are based on a cadet's participation, achievement, and service during the quarter being scored. The scoring criteria and point values are taken from the draft Cadet of the Month pamphlet from the Cadet Programs library. The Cadet of the Quarter shall wear a burgundy shoulder cord on the service or service dress uniform for the quarter following their selection.
  
2. Score Determination:
  - A. Participation
    - i. Attend a Squadron Meeting – 1
    - ii. Attend a Weekend Activity – 3
    - iii. Attend a Multi-Day Cadet Activity – 8
    - iv. Renew CAP membership - 8
  - B. Achievement
    - i. Pass an Achievement Test - 5
    - ii. Score 90% or Better on Achievement Test - 8
    - iii. Pass an Event in the Cadet Physical Fitness Test - 1
    - iv. Score a "Satisfactory" on a Uniform Inspection - 2
    - v. Score an "Excellent" on a Uniform Inspection - 4
    - vi. Earn a Promotion - 8
    - vii. Earn an award - 5
    - viii. Earn a Model Rocketry Badge – 5
    - ix. Earn Honor Roll at School – 12
  - C. Service
    - i. Bring a Friend to a Squadron Meeting - 5
    - ii. Recruit a New Member – 10
  
3. Each quarter, every cadet starts at 0 to ensure a level playing field. The cadet commander or deputy cadet commander will maintain the score sheet. At the end of the quarter, the scores are compared and the cadet with the highest score is named as the Cadet of the Quarter. In the event of a tie, the Cadet Commander, Deputy Commander for Cadets, and Squadron Commander will review the progress and achievements of the

cadets with the tied scores and determine the winner. If the Cadet Commander is one of the cadets tied for top score, only the Deputy Commander for Cadets and Squadron Commander shall make the decision.
