MEMORANDUM FOR COLORADO WING MEMBERS

SUBJECT: Selection Priority for Student Cadet Applicants

1. The selection priority for student cadets at the 2016 and subsequent Colorado Wing Encampment will be as follows:

- a. First Priority: Any Phase I or Phase II cadet who has not previously attended an encampment.
- b. Second Priority: Cadets who have attended only one encampment.
- c. Third Priority: Any other cadet.

2. Within each of these priorities, selection and slot assignment is based on the application acceptance date and time at the Encampment Admin Office. Application processing will be in the order received; however, no applications will be processed until after the application window opening date. Application acceptance is based on submission of a complete and accurate application packet with full payment of encampment fees.

3. When the number of accepted applicants exceeds the available slots, subsequent applicants are placed on a wait list. It is likely that some applicants will move from the wait list to the primary list if applicants on the primary list withdraw from encampment for any reason.

4. The date of opening of the application window will be announced, via E-Mail, to all COWG members using the COWG Announcements E-Mail list. Squadron Commanders will receive a separate E-Mail announcing the date so that they can facilitate the application process within their respective units. The opening date for application submission will also be posted on the Encampment Website.

5. The application window will likely open in March with a deadline in mid to late May. The application packets will be available approximately one week prior to the opening of the application window
